<p>Instrumental Music</p>	<p>Notification, enrolment and payment</p>	<p>Applications and information booklets for private music tuition are available throughout the year from the front office and lessons may begin at the start of any term. For commencement in Term 1, application forms are due by Week 8, Term 4 of the previous year. Continuing students are to notify their teachers directly at the end of the year.</p> <p>Instruments offered through private providers are flute, clarinet, saxophone, trumpet, trombone, singing, guitar, drums, piano.</p> <p>Students are expected to commit to a minimum of one year's tuition.</p> <p>Fees: \$31 per individual lesson (30 minutes) \$19.50 per shared lesson (30 minutes)</p> <p>Private instrumental music teachers invoice families</p>
		<p>directly, not through the school.</p> <p>A music administration fee of \$40 (\$10 per term) is levied to cover the cost of the program and its coordination This will be invoiced to parents by the school.</p> <p>Highgate School also offers group tuition for violin, viola and cello for students in years 3 - 7 by the Department for Education-Instrumental Music teachers <u>free of charge</u>. It is a Department requirement that students commit to a minimum of one year's tuition.</p>
